## SAN DIEGO COUNTY ENGINEERING COUNCIL 2015 STUDENT ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

The San Diego County Engineering Council (SDCEC) is awarding student scholarships to those interested in pursuing a degree in engineering or a related field at a four-year university. Two scholarships will be awarded as follows:

- 1 ~ **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a University of California San Diego (UCSD), San Diego State University (SDSU), or University of San Diego (USD) undergraduate student enrolled in an ABET accredited engineering program or to a first-year graduate student enrolled at one the listed institutions.
- 1 ~ **\$250** scholarship will be awarded to a San Diego County community college student transferring to a San Diego County ABET accredited four-year university.

### ELIGIBILITY

#### **Undergraduate or first-year graduate students:**

Must be enrolled in an ABET accredited engineering program during the current 2014-2015 academic year at UCSD, SDSU or USD. Open to individuals with good academic standing of freshman through first-year graduate student. International students are also eligible. Students completing their education in Spring/Summer 2015 are not eligible. The award funding is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution for the 2015-2016 academic year.

#### **Community college transfer students:**

Must be transferring to an ABET accredited four-year engineering program at UCSD, SDSU, or USD for the 2015-2016 academic year. International students are also eligible. The award funding is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution for the 2015-2016 academic year.

\*Award Winners must be present at National Engineers Week Awards Banquet to receive scholarship award.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed application form (attached).
- Resume to include the following (minimum):
  - Work Experience (company name, dates/hours worked, job duties, major contributions)
  - Professional Organization Affiliations (describe involvement and chair/board positions if applicable)

- Community Service/Involvement
  - Awards and Honors Received
  - Copy of unofficial transcript
  - One-page typed essay (choose only one of the following three prompts):
    - “What does being an engineer mean to you, and what made you want to become an engineer?”*
    - “Describe a skill or quality you possess that you feel is essential to being a successful engineer.”*
    - “What does “Sustainable Engineering” mean to you?” Provide one example each of sustainable and non-sustainable projects and discuss the merits of each relative to Sustainability. You are urged to research major industry publications such as ENR (Engineering News Report), Environmental Design and Construction, etc. for projects.*
- \*Please indicate prompt in the essay header.*
- An interview of the finalists may be required in February 2015.
  - NOTE: For Community College transfer students, or undergraduate students graduating in Spring/Summer 2015 and continuing on to graduate school, proof of acceptance into the future engineering program will need to be provided prior to the scholarship being awarded. However, proof need not be supplied at the time of application if pending.
